Winnipeg RV Rentals - A popular way for travelers to explore an area where there are no motels or hotels easily accessible is in an RV, which is normally known as a motorhome. They are also convenient in that travelers do not need to unpack and pack each night. In addition, they can stay in one place for as long as they like without spending a ridiculous amount on hotel accommodations. There are several classes of RVs on the market, and they are rated depending on their features and size. A class A recreational vehicle is the top of the line model.

There are many RV's on the market, ranging in different styles and sizes. The cheapest RVs tend to be ones that are not motorized and needs to be paired with another vehicle. These comprise campers which mount on the back of a truck, tent trailers, which pop into place, large trailers that require a heavy-duty truck to tow them and small trailers which can be towed by virtually any kind of vehicle. The motorized recreational vehicles are divided into three categories: class A, class B, and class C. Class B recreational vehicles are often nothing more than a conversion van with only the basics. Class C recreational vehicles, also referred to as mini-motorhomes, are normally fully self-contained and slightly bigger. Class A RV's are the largest units on the market and include all the necessities, along with several other features.

Class A RVs range in length from 30 to 40 feet, whereas the weights differ from 15,000 and 30,000 pounds. Depending on the kind, the recreational vehicle would sit upon a truck chassis or a specially made frame. The unit can either look like a bus or have a boxy look to it, depending on the model. Paint jobs and custom colors are common to make it more aesthetically nice.

A Class A RV has several basic amenities like a kitchen area with a stove and refrigerator, at least one bed and a bathroom. High-end models may have a separate bedroom, a living room, a slide-out, and plush carpeting. Generally, the bathroom in a class A motorhome is large enough to have a small tub. To compare, a class C bathroom has the handheld shower, toilet and sink all sharing the same tiny space. In order to help make a class A recreational vehicle's interior more aesthetically nice, custom cabinets can be added in the kitchen, leather furniture may be added, and upscale lighting fixtures could be installed. This helps to justify the large price tag which is connected with a class A RV. The price could normally be as high as \$100,000 or even higher, depending on the kind of recreational vehicle. However, to those individuals who consider their motorhome a home away from home, it is totally worth every penny.
